



# ISC Monday Night Racing March 5 - September 24

## NOTICE OF RACE

**INVITATION:** Island Sailing extends an invitation to all Capri 22 and Wavelength 24 or equivalent sailboat skippers to compete in the Monday Night Races on the Columbia River between I-5 and 205 bridges.

**DESCRIPTION:** The Monday Night Races is a regatta consisting of three series each being 7 weeks long plus lay days. These are sportif learning races with boat handling drills incorporated into each night of racing.

**ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS:** Races shall be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and OCSA General Sailing Instructions. Supplemental sailing instructions shall be communicated at the ISC Club House prior to 5:45 each night and again via VHF radio channel 72 prior to the first start. The Spring and Summer Series is open to Capri 22's and Wavelength 24's or boats with similar handicaps upon the discretion of the ISC Racing Group Committee. This is a modified one design regatta focused on learning. All penalties will be exonerated by 360° turns.

**DATES AND TIMES:** The first warning signal is 6:25 each Monday with addition warning signals occurring approximately 5 minuets after the last finisher of the previous race. There will be 3 series of 7 racing nights.

**Spring Series:** First official race will be on Monday March 12. And will last for 7 weeks with addition days added for no race nights.

**Summer Series:** Will begin by May 28, sooner if the 5 lay days in the Spring Series are not used.

**Fall Series:** The last series of the year is exclusively reserved for ISC Racing Group Members as ISC's Annual Trophy will be decided during this series.

**REGISTRATION:** There is no registration or fees required. All boats must have full insurance and agree to race at their own risk. The Race Committee would like to know who is coming before hand, but will allow other boats to register once the "Come within Hail" flag is flown off the committee boat.

**COURSES:** The Start/Finish Line is between Buoys "2" and 14. The Race Committee will place orange racing marks as needed. The courses will be announced by the Race Committee prior to the starting sequence of each race as multiple races will be sailed. These short courses preclude the use of typical OSCA and SYSCO race courses in the Racebook.
