

SYSCO Single Handed Beer Can June 16



NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION: As part of the OCSA Beer Can Races, SYSCO welcomes all boats, sailors, family, and friends to a casual beer can race. SYSCO is also challenging sailors to compete in a singlehanded race that will start after the regular beer can race.

DESCRIPTION: This beer can race is intended to promote a fun time on the river and new skippers for boat entrants are encouraged. This is a great way to introduce racing to crew members and friends who are interested to see what racing is all about. The first start will be all boats that have more than one person aboard. The second start will be for single-handed boats. We encourage all racers to get a few similarly matched boats together and test your skill in single-handed racing.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the OCSA General Sailing Instructions, except that class divisions, if any, will be determined by the Race Committee on-the-water: this changes OCSA General Sailing Instructions 5. Entrants agree to comply with the provisions of the OCSA General Sailing Instructions, and specifically the Disclaimer of Liability and Insurance Requirements of sections 20 and 21.

DATE AND TIME: Saturday, June 16, warning signal at 1700 hours.

REGISTRATION: Pass by the committee boat before you start and tell them your boat name, sail number, and in which start you are racing. Be sure they acknowledge you. That's it.

FEES: None

CLASS DIVISIONS: None

COURSES: Courses will be determined by the Race Committee and will be posted on the committee boat.

SCORING: Skippers are expected to note their finish position relative to others and report such information to anyone willing to attach significance to its importance. The race committee may record the finish times for the single-handed racers and may reveal the information for a suitable bribe.

PROTESTS: Protests are emphatically discouraged. Skippers are encouraged to settle alleged infringements of the racing rules in a private, Corinthian spirit.
