Eligibility & Instructions

This is an offshore race. This race is limited to boats of 24 feet overall length and longer. Entrants must take all responsibility for the safety of their vessel and crew and are strongly encouraged to meet the minimum safety equipment requirements of the Pacific International Yachting Association for this type of race. A cruising class may be available depending on entries. A skippers meeting and pre-race social will be held Friday July 27 in Astoria. On Sunday the 29th a welcome party and trophy presentation will be held at the Yaquina Bay Yacht Club in Newport
