INVITATION TO RACE

INVITATION: Rose City Yacht Club invites all eligible boats to participate in the first race of the year. The Frostbite Regatta will be held on the Columbia River between the I-5 and I-205 bridges.

DESCRIPTION: This is a one-day regatta consisting of two or more races.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the OCSA General Sailing Instructions. The regatta is open to all boats sailing in a One-Design, PHRF, Level, or Cruising class. All entrants shall comply with the rules governing their class.

DATE AND TIMES: Racing will be on Saturday, March 16. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1300 hours. Additional races will begin shortly after all boats in an individual class have finished.

REGISTRATION: Eligible boats shall enter and pay online at www.sailpdx.org before the registration deadline of 1700 local time two days before the race. No late registrations or on-the-water registrations will be accepted.

FEES: The entry fee is \$35 for all competitors who are not members of RCYC. All entrants must be current OCSA members to enter this race.

CLASS DIVISIONS: Any changes as well as class breaks will be posted on the official notice board at www.sailpdx.org, not later than 2200 hours the evening before the race.

TROPHIES: Awards will be presented at the OCSA Awards Party.

COURSES: The OCSA General Sailing Instructions and Courses will be used and are available in the OCSA Racebook.
