INVITATION TO RACE

INVITATION: The OCSA member clubs are pleased to extend an opportunity for skippers to compete in these not-so-serious, somewhat whimsical, and just-forfun, beer can races from May through September.

DESCRIPTION: So, have you been dreaming about that tropical destination that you have not been able to travel? Well...here's your chance to dream a little more... Don your favorite "Tropical Garb" and come out for our Beer Can Race!! Your committee boat will be judging to see which boat displays the best "TROPICAL DREAM" ...and will award a FABULOUS PRIZE to the most tropical race boat!! Stay tuned to channel 72 to hear the winner announced sometime during the race!

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the OCSA General Sailing Instructions, except that class divisions, if any, will be determined by the Race Committee on-the-water and no trophies will be awarded; this changes OCSA General Sailing Instructions 5 and 19. Entrants agree to comply with the provisions of the OCSA General Sailing Instructions, and specifically the Disclaimer of Liability and Insurance Requirements of sections 20 and 21. PHRF ratings are not required, but may be applied and adjusted by the Race Committee based upon the bribe, or lack thereof, by a competitor.

DATE AND TIME: Sunday, May 19 - The 5 min warning will start at 1:00 pm **REGISTRATION:** Pass by the committee boat before the start and tell them your boat name and sail number. Be sure they acknowledge you. That's it!

FEES: None! Entrants are encouraged to gratuitously solicit Race Committee favoritism by proffering consumable goodies, before, during or after each race. **CLASS DIVISIONS:** The Race Committee may or may not post class divisions

CLASS DIVISIONS: The Race Committee may or may not post class divisions depending upon bribes.

COURSES: Courses will be determined by the Race Committee and will be posted on the committee boat or announced on VHF 72.

SCORING: Skippers are expected to note finish position relative to others & report such information to anyone willing to attach significance to its importance. **HEARING REQUESTS:** Hearing requests are emphatically discouraged. Skippers are encouraged to settle alleged infringements of the racing rules in a private, Corinthian spirit.

COMMUNICATIONS: In case of a "Come Within Hail" (Code "L") signal display, pass by the committee boat for additional instruction. Extortion on the part of the Race Committee shall not be prohibited. Indeed, it may be expected.
